

About 5ft 7ins, and of dark complexion. A number of us had been sent up the line to hold a section of trench, Wyatt and I were amongst the number. Wyatt was a machine gunner, he was killed instanting by a shell quite close to me. I do notk know anything of the burial.

He was a Pte. in A.Cy 2nd Pltn, short, dark, thickset. He was hit by pieces of shell in the head in front of Anger Wood, near Lihons on 11th Aug: about 11 a.m. killed instantly. Four others were hit by the same shell (2 killed 2 wounded) an anti-tank shell. We were just moving out & left them all in the tranch. I do not know where he was buried, but probably in bir grave for 19 men buried near the wood.

Rote: Lt. Heyers is certain that Mystt was one of the men lying dead, but was not sure of his description, which was furnished by Pte. R. Gunn, 7603. A.C. 9th 3th, who was in Orderly Room when I was taking this report.

H. J. Cowan Confirmed by Sgt. H. Keogh 6046, A. Coy, 9th 8th London Saw him hying dead about 3 p.m. in atgrench Had been J.E.A. hit badly in head by a piece of shell. Description H. C. correct.

517", dark, age 35/36 Single. Queensland. It was general report at the Unit that Wyatt was hit on head by shrapnel and killed instantly. The chap in front had both legs blown off and much cut up by same shrapnel at Leon's stunt on 11.8.18. I know nothing of burial and did not see him killed.
