I saw him killed at Ypres. He was caught by a piece of shell, during an attack there, he fell into a shell hole, and was unconscious when I last saw him. I knew him very well, he came from Fortitude Valley, Brisbane. I do not know place of burial, and I cannot refer to anyone. There was a heavy bombardment on at the time, and which lasted many hours.
