

## "Killed in action - 20-8-18."

"I am not sure of locality, beyond Warfusee, about this date, was killed outright by shell while in the line. I wasn't there at the time. He was buried behind the tline. cross erected. I made the cross myself.

Grave is about 100 yards to left to main Road going to Amiens, close to a small clump of buildings that had been knocked to pieces. I saw the grave and erected the cross. Christian name Jack.
