#### "PRISONER OF WAR"

#### Interned Schneidemuhl.

"I have been suffering rather severely from an attack of Pleurisy and Pneumonia since 4th April. I am at present in the Camp hospital and well on the way to recovery. I received my 2nd. issue of clothing also two comforts parcels from Mrs. Bromley, Devenport for distribution among the man I mentioned in my last letter. We all thank you sincerely for the trouble you went to on our behalf.

Opl. Skelly before he left for Holland said he would write to you and explain my case. My cigarettes (300 per month) have been coming regularly up to date.

P.S. Pte. Wood is not quite recovered yet, so I have just written these few lines for him. 2007 Pte. F. Hanckel, I3th Battn., A.I.F. London 9/8/I8.
