"Killed April, 11th 1917."

"Of C. Coy. On 11th April, 1917 at Billicourt during our attack, we were in enemy's 1st line trench, when he was killed outright by shell. I didn't see it happen, but when I was going down the trench to reinforce part of the line, I passed his body, he was dead.

He would be left where he was killed.
