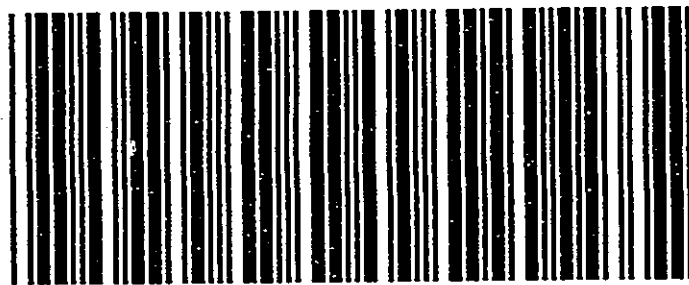

Edwards, Tynan and Mamwell were killed outright, and Scurrah was wounded, and subsequently died from wounds, by a direct hit of a shell on the guard room. They were on guard at Wormlow Camp, Clapham Road, near Danoutre. I forget what wounds Scurrah got. I saw them all buried in Danoutre Cemetery.
