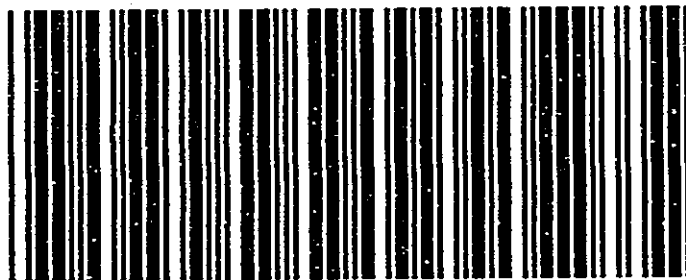

Private W.R. Tyrrell died here of Pleuresy at about 5 a.m. on the 25.7.18. He was buried at Croy 25.7.18. Plot 4 Row 15 Grave 10. I wrote full particulars to his Mother at the time of his death.

"Died of Wounds 23.7.18."

I knew Tyrrell. Men about 6ft., heavy build, brown hair. He came to our Battalion in December 1917, and fell sick and went into Hospital. Rejoined about 15th April 1918, looking very ill, was sent away on the 17th, joined up again in July, and sent away immediately, and died at Divisional Wing, at St. Leger of illness. I saw him when he rejoined in July 1918. He was a skeleton. He was accidentally scalded in bath at Boyes about 17th April; one leg burned.

He was in E Co., 5th platoon. He died in the dressing station in the Sunken Road off Sausage Gully on the 23rd August, and was buried in Sausage Gully. He was a great friend of mine. I did not myself see him buried, but I know one of the stretcher bearers who carried him to be buried. Pte Harrison of B Co., 5th platoon, was the S.B., who was with the battalion when I left on the 1st March. I know his (Tyrer's) number: he came from Ballarat district.
