I saw Lt. Stewart killed by shell fire. I think instantly mear Propart, about 6 to 7 s.m. We were advancing from the reserve trenches which we had left about 15-20 minutes before he was hit.

"KILLED 23-8-18"

He was in D.Ccy. and I saw him killed at Proyant, when death was instantaneous - he being hit by a piece of shell in the back. His batman whose name was Chesterton was killed with him. He had been wounded and was walking out to aid-post, when he was hit in the wrist by a piece of shell. He was a popular Officer and ceme from New South Wales. I saw his grave just outside Proyant on the field in a small Cemetery, his batman being buried beside him. Both graves were marked by a Cross having full details marked thereon. I was but 30 yerds away from them at time of casualty and both deaths were instantaneous.

I was told that he was hit in the wrist the same morning and was making his way back to the D/Station when he was killed. We held the ground. His body was lying about two kilomeetres to the rear of a 15" german gun which we had captured and near a large German Commetery. I do not remember the name of the place. I think he would be buried somewhere in the vicinity.
