I was in reserve on 4.4.18. Stier was in a stunt at Villers Bretonneux on 4.4.18. being 1st Lewis gunner. Stier was seen to be hit twice by M.G. bullet. He fell and was not seen again as far as we in the Unit, both 13th and 14 Co. could find out. He was a very popular chap in the Co. well known, hence our enquiries as to what became of him. The man in the Unit told us he was in the stunt. Don't know anything of burial.

Dear Sir

In answer to your enquiry for

1241 R/ep/ F.H. Stier 33rd Batt A.I.F.

wounded

who is officially reported missing since 4.4.18
we beg to state we have no further information concerning
his fate at present. News of the death or capture of men
reported "Missing" is necessarily slow in coming to
hand. Six weeks is the very shortest period that elapses
between a man's capture and the report of his being a
prisoner of war. A letter from him may be the first
intimation of his capture. Should you receive any
communication from him we beg of you to send us the
original or an exact copy immediately, as parcels of food
and clothing should be sent by our Prisoners of War
Department without delay.

If he has made the supreme sacrifice, an even longer
period may elapse before we can obtain details of his
death, but eventually we hope to do so and trust they
will be of some comfort in your sorrow.

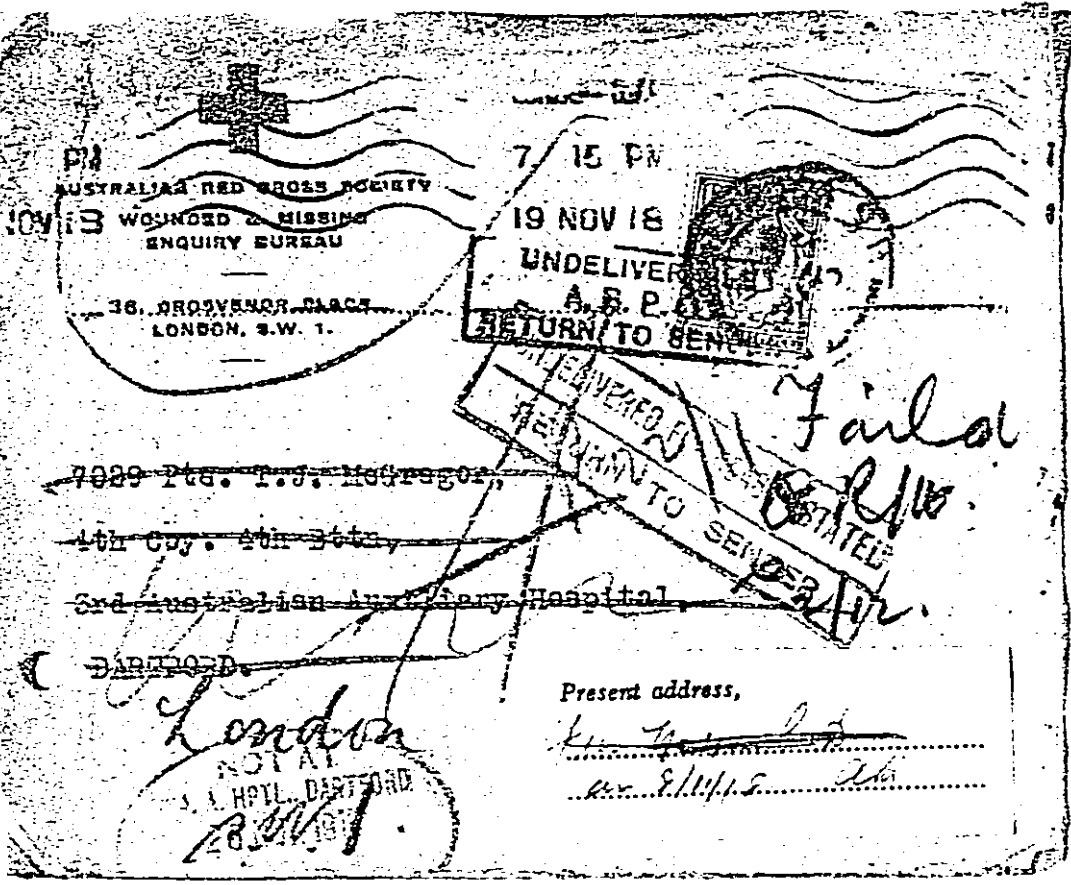
