The Germans attacked between 4.30 and 6 and Stillman looked over the parapet. He was turied near, but I am not certain of the exact spot. A cross was put up over the grave."

I knew Stillman well - he and I were in Zeitoun Machine Gun School together, and had our photos taken. He came from the 18th Battalion, his initial was 'W' and we called him 'Bill'. He was a fair-sized chap, growing grey.

He was killed on 15/4/17 when the Germans broke through at Lagnicourt, and I was told by men on the Gun - as I was on transport at the time - that he had been killed outright. I saw a large cross with his name on it for his grave - it was made by D.W.McQuiggen, who was afterwards killed. We re-took and held the ground where he was hit.
