I know Pt. Herbert W. Turner of A.Co., IV.Pln. He was a Dairy Man at Claremont, Western Australia. He was sitting with me, and a number of others at a cross road in front of Bullecourt on April 11th.1917, daybreak, when a shell exploded amongst us; he got the full force, and was killed instantly. I was wounded by the same shell. He was sitting next to me. I do not know whether his remains were buried. He held the ground.
