I saw him hit by a M/Gun bullet. He was a S/Bearer and he was just coming out of a shell hole to assist a Corporal when he was hit in the head, and was taken to the D/Station. This occurred on the 29th. Sept. I heard after that he died. This happened in front of Bovey. He came from Victoria, was married, with three children. He was in the same Platoon.

Pte Slater of the 2nd Pioneers was admitted to this C.C.S. on the 30th September last being mortally wounded in the head. He was given every attention by capable nursing sisters but I regret to say he died, in comfortable surroundings, on the 3rd October. He was buried the following day at Doingt (near Peronne)

Height 5'10", medium complexion, age 38/40. On 29th Sept. '18 we were at Ronsey nr Bony. Abt. 2 days after word came to our men Slater had been shot in the neck by bullet at Ronsey, & we afterwards heard he died. Know nothing further. Slater was a stretcher bearer and was very daring in getting in the wounded. I knew him personally. We left Australia together.
