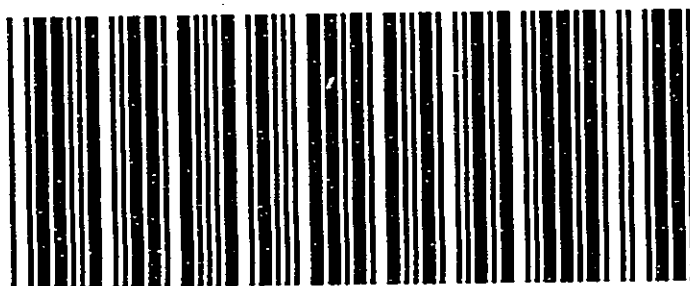

He was taken out of the trench wounded along the Menin Road near Passchendaele. He was never heard of again. Heavy shelling was going on. I knew him well, thin, slightly build, dark, think he came from Surrey Hills, Sydney, not long with the Battn. 21 or 22 years old. I saw him wounded.
