

Interned Lager I Munster.

"I have been to the Doctor here several times, but I have not got any treatment, I get most painful headaches and shooting pains in mythead and my sight seems to be failing. I am very much worried with my eyes. It will be most miserable for me if anything happens after pulling through so far. My dear wife is totally blind. It would be a God send if anything could be done for me, if only for my wife's safe. I get hardly any letters from home or from my friends. I have not received one from my wife this year. My parcels are arriving up to date now."
