I knew Hartnup: he was in my platoon in B.Co. On 11th. April, during the attack on Bullecourt, the Co. had to retire and I took refuge in a dug-out in the Sunken Road. Hartnup was also in this dug-out. We both left the dug-out together and went different ways. I got back to our lines but Hartnup was not seen again. I think he may have been taken prisoner.
