The above was a tent mate of witness'. They were together at the landing at Anzac. At about 4 p.m. on the day of the landing 47 men got out off from the 6th Btn. Witness and all the above were amongst these. Only 7 of the 47 got back to the Australian lines. Witness was amongst the 7 who got back. The remainder must have been shot down. It is conceivable that he was taken prisoner but, judging from what happened at the time and statements he has heard since, witness is quite sure he was killed.
