

If Hooper G. W.B. is the one I know whose initials are the same he was a Corporal when he met his death. It was on the Armentieres front and Hooper and others had volunteered to take a position in the frost line during a retalistion. A me rifle grounds came over exploding a box of beads killing threemen and wounding the 4th. Hooper was one of the killed and should be buried in the cometery near at square Farm. He was tell, dark, very clean out features and pleasant manner, about 24 years old.

The one who escaped was a Corporal of M.G who had been wounded before at Posieres.

I am pretty sure this is the man who was killed by a shell which hit a box of bombs in a certain bay in the trench. It killed him straight out, striking him through the head. I saw him lying dead myself. He was a Los.Cpl. and he was going the next day to England to get a commission. I think he was a relation or friend of our Brigadier, General Cannon. I have seen his grave in Armentieres Cemetery.

In Square East meeter, immentieres, about cut of February I saw Heaper killed in the front line trench. We were making a raid at the time and Heaper was let beyonet man with the M.G. teem posted in our front line to cover the return of cur man. Until they were on the way back I saw a shell cut the M.Gun in half and land in and explode a box of bombs. Three of the teem were killed and three wounded. I was in the same bay within 5 yards of it. Hooper was standing almost on the bombs. His head was badly knocked about and he must have died instantly. I last saw his body in the mortuney and have no doubt he was properly buried somewhere about inventiores. The other two men killed were H.Leng and spetter. His number is about 350. Comes from Cantral V. Queensland where his father has a big station. Come over in the Bennethenes, leaving Australia 16th May, 1916. He was in B.

I saw his body being carried with others on a tram-truck to Head-quarters for burial at Armentieres. Lieut. Woods Headquarters (M.G.) was the O.C. in charge when Hooper was killed and may know more. Hooper was a L. M. G. Cpl.Stewart was in charge of his section and is in England wounded, but I don't know his initials or where he is.
