I saw him lying dead with about 10 others - all killed by one shell, near Gleasorse wood, on 21st September - early morning. He was placed knocked about a good deal, but quite recognisable. He must have been killed outright; his nack was injured. They were not buried at the time. The bodies were all put on the parapet.

"I knew Casualty. He was a tall man, well built, medium complexion, about 26 years of age, known as "Bert". He was a 23rd Rfotz, man of the 5th Battalion and he embarked in the transport "Horato". Casualty was in the front line trench at Passchendaele. I was 5 yds. away from him when an H.E. shell exploded on the parapet burying Casualty and killing him instantly. He was most severely wounded all over. He was buried just outside the trench near where he fell and I helped to bury him. I was an eve-witness." an eye-witness."
