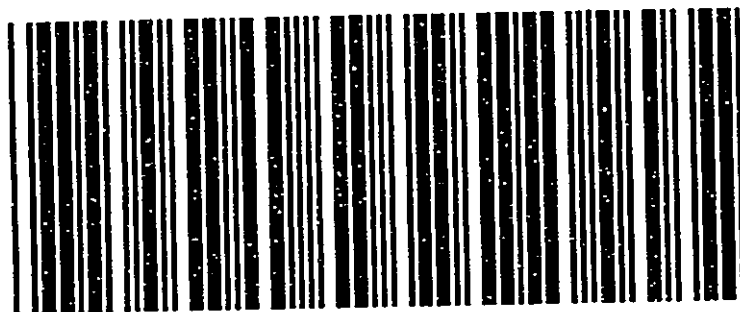

I knew a Fischer in the 49th but I am not sure if this is the same man. The Fischer I knew was about 5 feet 8, clean shaven, very dark, and had a ruddy complexion. I think he had only come back from England in June. He was in No. VII Pltn, and I am in No. VIII. He was at Brayé - we had just done a successful stunt in the trench when the Germans put up a terrific bombardment and Fischer got killed instantly by a piece of shell. I saw him dead. He was killed on the post and was buried alongside the parapet. A cross with his name etc was put up over his grave. I saw his grave. The grave would be about 500 yards to the west of Brayé in a direct line, with the French Cemetery at Brayé. It is very close to a road about 300 yards towards Brayé from the French Cemetery.
