I am not now sure what company he belonged to but I knew him well. embarked with him at Port Melbourne on S.S. "Commonwealth" Sept. 19/16. 5'7" in height, stout, fair and 27 years of age. He was an Englishman. At Vauvillers on Aug. 9/18 in the forencon he was engaged in the attack on the German lines when he was Killed instantly by machine gun fire. I saw his dead body on the battlefield. I know nothing of burial.
