## "Killed in action 7.10.17.

Curry was apprenticed with me at "Coupland and Waddell", 17 Day Street, City, before we enlisted. He left Australia with No. 6650, W. Ashby as a 19th Reinforcements to the 19th Battalion. Ashby wrote to me whilst we were in England wounded about the middle of October 1917, telling me that Bill Curry had been killed outright - he was hit in the head by a "dud" shell at Passchendaele Ashby did not see it happen but as he was a very reliable chap I feel sure he made certain of what he wrote me as we were all pals. Ashby has probably rejoined the Battalion. Curry's initials were W.C. and he lived at 38, The Avenue, Strathfield. I shall call on Curry's people as soon as I can.
