I knew L/Opl. Eric Cumming of D Co., 13th Pltn. a young short thickset boy. Tair. oleanshaven. I was about 20 yards from him in "no mens land" at Broodseinde Ridge on the 4th Oct. 1917. - daylight, when I saw him killed instantly by a shell which exploded close to him. The body was recognizable. We went on and took our objective and held it. I so not know where he was buried.

This was in Ypres sector but I can't tell the place too well. Cumming and Mears were killed outright. I was wounded and assisted out.

Cpl.Cumming was my pel and was with me when he was killed on the morning of the 4th Oct.1917. I wrote to his mother and gave her all particulars, but if they are of any use to you I am only too glad to give them again. Cpl.Cumming was killed on the morning of the 4th October 1917 between Anzac and Broodseinde Ridges in front of Ypres Blanders. I cannot say for certain if he was buried but as he was lying in a conspicuous place our burial parties would be almost certain to bury him. In that case he would have been buried on the field. He was a short thick set lad 20 years age, but he would have had plenty on ham for the burial parties to identify him.
