Blackburn was a S/B. and helped me to carry Ruse out, after a subsequent carry and return to the lines at Ravihe Wood, behind Hill 60, he was gassed and reported himself, without aid, to the dressing station at Spailbank. I saw him there about 7 a.m. Report came back that he died that day, about the same time as Ruse - 4-45 p.m.
