Enlisted 20/8/15, Next of Kin, Mr.J.Weir, 58 Harrison St., Marrickville,
Sydney. Left Australia 11th Rfs. to 2nd. He was killed in Sausage
Gully by a piece of shrapnel at 3 o'clock on 17/8/16 and buried at
Gordon Dump Cemetery Sausage Gully. Was seen dead by Informant.
