

Informent saw Shields in the Wandsworth hospital No.1.Ward, over a month ago. Subsequently Shields went to Harefield and later on Informent saw him again when he told Informant that he was going back to Australia by next boat. Shields was "Armourer Sergeant", but Informant never saw nor knew him in the battalion and other wounded of the 4th Pionee's told Informant the same thing. (A pizzling case - searcher will inquire at the Headquarters embarkation Bureau.)


