Re 7932 Pte.P.McGuinness, 51st Battn. He was admitted here on 27-4-18 suffering from a gun shot wound of the left thigh which had badly fractured the pelvic bones. His case received the attention of the Consulting Surgeon frequently, but his condition did not improve. He died on 6-5-18 as the result of acute septicaemia. The funeral was at the British Military Cemetery, Mont Huon, Le Treport, on 8-5-18, and the ceremony was conducted by the Rev. T.O'Sullivan. The grave No. is 824B.

This patient was admitted here on 27/4/18 suffering from a gunshot wound of the left thigh which had badly fractured the pelvic bones. His case received the attention of the Consulting Surgeon frequently, but his condition did not improve.

He died on 6/5/18 as the result of acute septicaemia.

The funeral was at the British Military Cemetery Mont Huon, Le Treport, on 3/5/18, and the Ceremony was conducted by the Rev. T. O'Sullivan.
