Killed during stunt at Bresles near Beauvais. Been out on patrol and on returning was cantour chasing (flying very low) and he flew into a hill. Primrose and machine smashed up. Buried near where machine crashed. Primrose's uncle, Air Mechanic of No. 2 Squad. known as "Primmie" witnessed the burial.

Informant has photo of grave with cross erected made out of an aeroplane propellor. Build about 5ft 8ins, fair, slim, professional footballer from Melbourne - Victoria.
