Lieut. L. Robinson went out in charge of a platoon of men as an advance party on a night early in May at Quinns Post. Both of the above were in this platoon, No X. Only three men returned. These were Cpl. L.F. Cousins, EM C. Co, Pte, Milford (now in M.G.S.) and Pte. Smith C.Co.

Cousins and Milford are at the front in France and could give further information. One of them said he believed he saw Paterson shot. The party was believed to have been sent out into a trap by a German officer who got into the Australian trenches.
