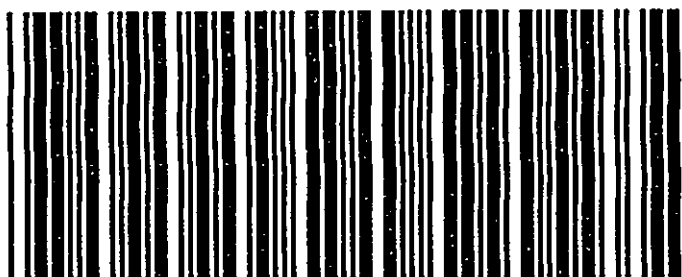

28th Battalion. A.I.F. (who is now officially reported Killed
in Action on 29.7.16. having previously been reported Missing)
We very much regret we have up to the present been able to obtain
no definite particulars of his fate. We have placed his name
on a new enquiry list we are making which is to be circulated
among the returned prisoners and in all camps and hospitals
in England and should we obtain any news of him we will at
once advise you.
