On their return from the front line Lt Murray remarked the Germans would never hit them and that they would get back all right. It was shortly after this that Mr Murray was killed by a shell and Sgt Ward was wounded in the left shoulder by the same shell and Sgt Chalmers escaped. Sgt Chalmers looked after Sgt Ward. I don't know if Ht Murray's body was recovered.

"Lt. Jack Murray had just got his Commission/was killed by a shell about the end of Cot. when going up to look at a position we were going to take in Front of Passchendaele. He was a friend of Stev. Ealor. I was told that some Australian Artillery men who knew him brought his body back. He was buried at Chattabell about a mile behind Ypres. I saw men making a cross with his name for the grave."

I know Lieut Hurray well; he was C.C.M.Sergt and had his star a month before he was killed. He was medium height, thickset, fair, and about 25. He came from Queensland and was an allrowed athleter.

On the 29th October at Ypres; he has sent up towards Westhock Ridge in charge of an observing porty. A shell fell, and Mr. Murray was killed. I has at Ypres and did not see the body nor burial, but I saw the Batta cross with the name, etc. being prepared. He was buried where he fell near westhock Ridge.
