Re No. 113, Pte. W.M. Rogers, 10th M.G.C., I have to inform you that he was admitted to this hospital in a very critical condition. His wounds were, as follows:-

Three wounds of Abdomen (Wall being penetrated)
Through and through wound of right thigh.
Two wounds feet.

He was unconscious on admission, dying on the 22.9.18, without regaining consciousness. He was interred in St. Sever Cemetery, Rouen, on the 23rd September 1918 - Grave Number:- 6651.

Informant says:- Was second in command of "Q" Squadron - was married, and came from Picton Junction, W.A. Third Brigade was moving up to reinforce Anzac Division on 31st. October, 1917. about 2 miles N.E. of Beersheba. 10th. Regiment were being heavily shelled, one bursting near him and wounding him very severely. Was sent back to Field Ambulance Hospital, but died shortly after. His Groom was wounded by same shell., but recovered. Was a school teacher before the War, and was always very popular with his men."
