This officer immediately displayed his usual leadership and initiative by dispatching a section to deal with the guns and himself led an assault on the Post forcing them to best a hasty retrest. The advance was pushed to the road where the patrol was met by With great coolness Lieut. a superior force. YOUNG organised the withdrawal which was completed after giving assistance to the section dealing with the M.O's wit hout camualties.
