Lieutenant Leopold BULL.	<p>For conspicuous gallantry and ability as Battalion Intelligence Officer in action near ALBERT on 5th April, 1918.</p> <p>After the delivery of our counter attack he led a patrol forward to clear up the situation and to locate the position and strength of the enemy with a view to a further counter attack. In carrying out this task for which he had volunteered he was severely wounded within 30 yards of the enemy line. He was able to give valuable information on being brought in a couple of hours later.
