He immediately opened fire on the party with his Lewis Gum causing a number of casualties. It was due to his very prompt action that the attack was delayed and finally driven off. His work during the whole tour in the line was excellent. 45th 3525 Private For courage and devotion to duty on the night Villiam GIBSON. 2/3 May near VILLERS BRETOHNEUX. Battelion A.I.F. Then all telephone lines with the front were broken he worked continuously all night under very heavy shell fire repairing the lines and Bucceeded in keeping Battalion Headquarters in communication with the front line, thereby enabling information of the greatest value to be transmitted without delay.
