After the objective had been gained on 9th August 1918 near RAINECOURT, east of AMIENS, wounded men were observed 250 yards in advance of the position. These men salvaged a stretcher and went forward under heavy machine gun and shell fire, bound up their wounds and carried them back to safety.
