This N.C.O. was alone in an advanced sniping position on the Russell Top position at Anzac during the last 10 hours of the evacuation. His vigilance and keen observations were responsible for obtaining valuable information as to the movements of the enemy, which he promptly reported. On a previous occasion in Company with Sgt. Brennan (who has since received the D.C.M.) he reconnoitred the enemy position on the PEE in daylight as far as their front line trenches, and sketched same. He also reconnoitred Malone Gully and Sniper's Nest, and led an unsuccessful attack with 10 men against the latter stronghold. Although 6 of his party were wounded severely by machine gun fire, he got them all away under heavy fire.
