This Officer as Brigade Major, has carried out his duties in a most efficient manner. Since the 21st March, the Brigade has been continuously engaged, first in launching attacks against the then victoriously advancing enemy in the vicinity of HANGARD, South East of AMIENS, where the work of a Brigade Major was most arduous and complex owing to the Brigade being engaged with the French Troops, and again during operations North of the SOMME in May and June 1918, and South of the SOMME in July and August, 1918, the latter month including the operations of the 8th and succeeding days, East of AMIENS. Again during the operations from the 28th to 31st August, 1918, his work has been of a particularly responsible and arduous kind.

His assistance and fore-sight during the preparations for the attack on MONT ST.QUENTIN were of great value to the Units engaged in the attack. During all these operations, this Officer's work has been of the highest order and the perfect manner in which he carried out his many duties was responsible for the perfect working of all the Units of the Brigade and the complete success of the operations.
