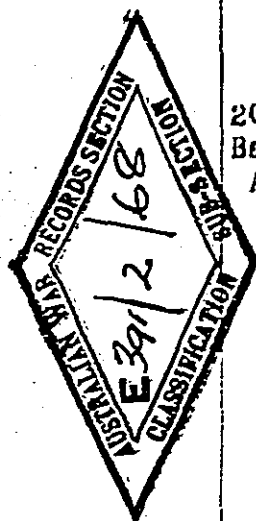

Battalion A.I.F.	5575	Private Herbert L A N A G A N	<p>This man is a Battalion runner, and was sent on an urgent message to 4 companies in the line, near FRANKERVILLE, east of AMIENS, on the 11th. August, 1918. His task was a most dangerous one; he was continually under the fire of machine guns, and snipers. For some time he was forced to take cover in a shell hole on account of the concentrated fire that was brought on him. He eventually delivered the despatches and brought back information that was urgently needed at Headquarters.
