During the attack near VILLERS ERETORNEUX on 4th July, 1318 this soldier, with a Medede was running a line to Coy. H.Q. They came in contact with a party of the enemy who had been minued by the edvancing waves. The germans immediately opened fire with rifles and bombs and wounded the B.C.D. Pts. Eliza rushed them single-handed and, throwing a bomb in their midst completely denoralised them. Help arrived shortly afterwards and the remainder of the party were either killed or taken prisoner.

21st Sn. Cpl. Eugene Loftus 1545 GARLAND A-leis

At VILLERAS BARTOHNEUX during the attack on 4.7.13 this Hedede was in charge of a Lewis Gune

On the objective being reached a rortion of the line was harassed by heavy snining from a forward communication trench, this N.C.O. rushed out with his gun although under heavy sniping fire and forced the enemy to withdraw. He continued to pursue them and inflicted further losses and thuc allowed the consolidation to · Despord

Again on the 5th July during a minor operation this H.C.O. pushed out into NO HAH'S LAND and inflicted heavy losses on the enemy and forced him to withdraw. He was wounded but carried on until the situation was cleared up.
