Finding that a M.J. was holding up the advance of the attacking intentry, he pushed forward with one of his guns and continued in the face of heavy energy fire, to fire his gun until the Machine Gun was blown out thus enabling the attack to proceed.

with his number he mushed a German Post, capturing 8 prisoners.

ills work throughout the whole action was of a very high order and his cheerful energy in the face of great difficulties, of great value to his men.
