At ZONNEBERKE on 4.10.17 during the attack this B.C.O. took charge of and re-organised his platoon after the officer had been killed. When their advance was temporarily checked by an enemy post he rushed forward and bombed the Machine Gun their and captured 15 prisoners.

On arrival at the objective he selected the line for his men to dig in and remained constantly on duty under the heaviest bombardments supervising the work and encouraging the men.

At BROODSEINDE on 9.10.17 his dash and determination materially contributed to the establishing of our line in its new position.

Throughout the whole of the operations his personal bravery, his qualities of initiative and leadership have been exhibited to a marked degree.

When an enemy Machine Gunner killed his Sergt. he at once leapt out and bombed the position killing the gun crew and capturing the Machine Gun. He then rallied the men and took them under his command leading them with vigour and determination to the assault of the final objective.
