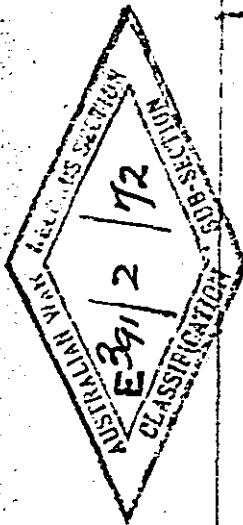

Although wounded at the commencement Corporal Harwood and his detached party succeeded in reaching their objective. After beating off one counter attack with loss Cpl. Harwood was forced to fall back to the supports and his subsequent efforts to regain the position failed under heavy Machine Gun fire.</p>	G. O. C. 6th. Aust. Infantry Brigade.	M. M.	
	22nd. Bn.	2346	Sergeant Patrick Thomas <u>McCORMACK</u>	<p>For distinguished gallantry on 25/2/17 in command of his platoon under heavy Machine Gun fire at DINKUM SPUR near WARLENCOURT. He led his men forward with great coolness and skill right up to the enemy's wire and eventually withdrew them in good order on receipt of instructions.</p>	G. O. C. 6th. Aust. Infantry Brigade.	M.
