For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty during the attack near BEAUREVOIR, East of PERONNE, on morning of 4th Oct., 1918.

This man set a splendid example to his section by pushing forward in advance of the wave, using his rifle most effectively as he went ahead. When within 100 yds. of an active machine gun he took up a position and by accurate rapid fire enabled the remainder of his section to advance without loss, capturing the gun and mop up the post. During consolidation he again used his rifle with extraordinary ability, causing the enemy heavy casualties by his accurate and skillful marksmanship.

For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty during the attack near BEAUREVOIR, East of PERONNE, on 4.10.18.

While the attack was in progress this man was constantly ahead of his section acting as a scout. He located the enemy posts and drew their fire, directing the moppers-up towards their objective. During this stage of the attack he displayed courage much beyond the ordinary and ably assisted his officers. Later in the advance he located an enemy machine gun and while directing the party which subsequently mopped it up, he fell severely wounded. The services rendered by this plucky soldier were invaluable.
