This Officer was in charge of the A.D.S. at CACHY and GENTELLES during the period of operations from 21st to 27th April, 1918.

During the enemy attack on 24th April, the A.D.S. at CACHY was blown up by shell fire, and was transferred to GENTELLES.

The A.D.S. there was shelled throughout, nevertheless evacuation proceeded steadily.

He gallantly made several journeys to the R.A.P. under extremely heavy fire and located and disposed of all casualties collected there.

His zeal, courage and untiring energy were beyond all praise.
