|                                    | 9TH BATTERY | -          | CAPTAIN Francis<br>Webb FAULKNER, M.C.            | <p><b>FOR IMMEDIATE AWARD.</b></p> <p>The 9th Battery Position near VEUILLE COURT was suddenly subjected to a heavy burst of H.E. and gas shells about 8-30 pm on the night 3rd September 1918. The detachments were living in dug-outs in a trench and seven men were wounded.</p> <p>Capt. Faulkner, though himself suffering from the effects of gas, carried wounded men from gas-filled dug-outs which had received direct hits, and applied Field Dressings until the arrival of the R.H.C.</p> <p>Owing to a shortage of men he then assisted to carry the wounded men through a heavy barrage to the Dressing Station 1 1/2 miles away.</p> <p>He set a fine example of courage to the personnel of the Battery at a critical time, and showed a total disregard for his personal safety.</p> <p><i>Walter Cohen</i><br/>Brig.
