During the attack on 2/3rd instant, Private Stephen Colenam Sinclair displayed great gallantry, prompt action and devotion to duty.

While acting as Platoon Runner he and his Platoon Commander ran into eight Germans only six yards away on a road. His Platoon Commander was wounded immediately. Sinclair shot two Germans, took four prisoners and the remaining two ran away. He carried his Platoon Commander under fire to Dressing Station and then returned to his Unit.
