3145 Sergeant During our attack upon the BLUE IZNE on 11th August 1913, on the left flank Sgt. WALTER showed great bravery and devotion to duty. When the N.C.O. in charge of a bombing party was wounded Sgt. WALTER rushed forward under heavy Dale B. 8. 18. machine gun fire, caught up the wounded man and was carrying him to shelter when he himself was slightly wounded and the W.C.O. killed in his IN Man arms: He, however, brought the body of the wounded H.C.O. back to our lines, and taking command of the section led the men forward with great smill against the enemy, dislading them, and gaining their section of trench under disputs.
