These five men were mentioned by the Comm^d Officer, 4th Battalion, in whose sector of defence 'B' Coy of 12th Bn were employed: he stated in a message dated 9th Aug. that he had already mentioned their names in his report to his Brigadier. I have written to the C.O. 4th Bn for details of the acts of bravery of the men & hope to be able to forward same shortly, although I understand most Officers of 4th Bn are either killed or wounded or the away sick.
