For conspicuous gallantry at Stamwood South East of Corbie on 4 th July 1918. This N.C.O. was in charge of a section carrying laid wire and was himself loaded with a coil of wire. Immediately on leaving the jumping off place he was severely wounded one arm being rendered useless. Despite his wound he led his section to the dumps arriving with a complete bag and carrying on to his objective. He passed his men on his line. For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty at Vaire Wood South East of Corbie on 4 th July 1918. This N.C.O. was one of a forward party laying cable behind the assaulting waves. Though compelled to fight during the passage of the wire he carried his wire to his objective and established communication. From then on for 48 hours he continually patched the lines which were broken by enemy shells. The wire was heavy enough to stop him and it was largely due to his position shelling and so on that for danger that no broken communication existed from Battalion to all Companies throughout the whole operation.	8/7/18	M.M.
