He served with the battery at GALLIPOLI throughout the whole of the campaign, and since his arrival with the Battery in FRANCE has, on all occasions and during the whole time the Battery has been in the line, carried out the duties of No.1 without relief. On numerous occasions this N.C.O has organized and controlled parties for extinguishing burning camouflage & fires in gun pits. His coolness, resourcefulness and fearlessness under fire sets and maintains in his gun detachment a high standard of efficiency and fire discipline even under the most trying circumstances. His sound judgment, his energy, his general efficiency & devotion to duty have at all times been most conspicuous, and have set a very high standard to all other N.C.O's and men of the Battery.
